
The library and its branches will be closed in observance of Thanksgiving on Thursday, November 23rd.

Crisp fall air makes me want to cozy up with a great book, a warm beverage, and my dog. Luckily, the CWPL book club collection can help me with the "great book" part! This month we added some excellent book club sets. Ask your book club contact person about getting on the lists for:







Tom Lake by Ann Patchett: Both hopeful and elegiac, this book explores what it means to be happy even when the world is falling apart.

Remarkably Bright Creatures by Shelby Van Pelt: An exploration of friendship, reckoning, and hope, tracing a widow's unlikely connection with a giant Pacific octopus.

The Southern Book Club's Guide to Slaying Vampires by Grady Hendrix: Fried Green Tomatoes and Steel Magnolias meet Dracula in this Southern-flavored supernatural thriller set in the '90s about a women's book club that must protect its suburban community from a mysterious and handsome stranger who turns out to be a blood-sucking fiend.

Kind reminder to all book clubs:

The CWPL is very happy to be able to provide our Book Club program to our Wexford County patrons. To make sure the service runs smoothly and meets the needs of all book clubs, we ask book club members to remember these rules:

- Book club sets can ONLY be checked out by the Contact Person for the book group.
- Book Club sets of books MUST BE RETURNED AS A
 COMPLETE SET. We will no longer be accepting individual
 book returns of book club titles. If you check out a set with 8
 books, please return all books in that set at the same time. The
 contact person is responsible for making sure all the books that
 are checked out are returned. If you need some help with how
 to organize this, please reach out.
- Finally, popular book club sets with reserves will be held for book clubs at Circulation for 1 week. If your club does not pick up the book in that week, the books will move on to the next club and you will be added to the bottom of the list.
